This form is to be signed by the legal guardian of a young person under the age of 18, together with the young person. Carers of adults at risk should also sign the form in the presence of the adult at risk.

Please note that if you have more than one child/adult at risk registered you will need to complete separate forms for each.

Churchdown Village Bowls Club (CVBC) recognises the need to ensure the welfare and safety of all young people and adults at risk in bowls and as part of our commitment to ensure their safety we will not permit photographs, video images or other images to be taken or used without your consent.

CVBC will follow the guidance for the use of images of young people or adults at risk as detailed within the CVBC Child Protection Policy and Procedures. (Copy on our website)

CVBC will take steps to ensure these images are used solely for the purposes for which they are intended i.e. the promotion and celebration of the activities of CVBC.

IF YOU BECOME AWARE THAT THESE IMAGES ARE BEING USED INAPPROPRIATELY YOU SHOULD INFORM THE CVBC SAFEGUARDING OFFICER IMMEDIATELY

The photographs may be made available on the clubs/county's website, Facebook and or Twitter pages. If at any time either the parent/guardian/carer wishes the data to be removed from the website, 7 days' notice must be given to allow data to be removed.
