

Safeguarding concerns reporting procedure Churchdown Village Bowls Club (CVBC)

(To be used when concerns arise about the behaviour of a member of staff, coach or volunteer within affiliated sports organisation towards an adult/ child or children (such as concerns about poor practice or allegations of abuse).

Is the child in immediate danger or are they injured? If so, contact the emergency services first,

Within 24 hrs



The Safeguarding Officer to consult with the County Safeguarding Officer and/or NGB Safeguarding Officer and/or children/adult social care, police, LADO or NSPCC helpline to determine further action to be taken.

Within 24 hrs



Within 24 hrs

Record the actions taken and agreed, including who will inform the parents or emergency contact in the case of adults

Within 24 hrs

Lower-Level Concerns

Possible Child abuse or criminal offence

Deal with concern using complaints or disciplinary procedures

Make a referral to children's social care, LADO or police within 24 hours and records the actions taken and agreed.

Undertake disciplinary investigation and hold hearing.

Consider what support is needed for the referrer or others involved,

Consider what support is needed for the referrer or others involved

Consult with statutory services or NGB Disciplinary lead to decide on:

Possible outcomes:
No case to answer.
Advice or warning given.
Training and support needed.
Other Sanctions.
Exclusion.

Start disciplinary process only if statutory services agree.
Seek support from LADO.

Refer to DBS if you organisation thinks an individual has caused harm or poses a risk to others.

Outcome of statutory services investigations:
No further action.
Criminal Prosecution.
Assessment of risk.
Other

Disciplinary appeals process

Undertake full disciplinary investigations and hold hearing.

Outcomes and possible appeal
